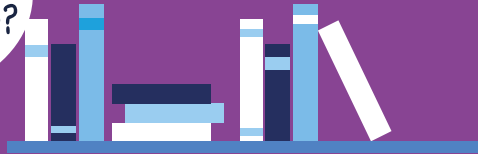

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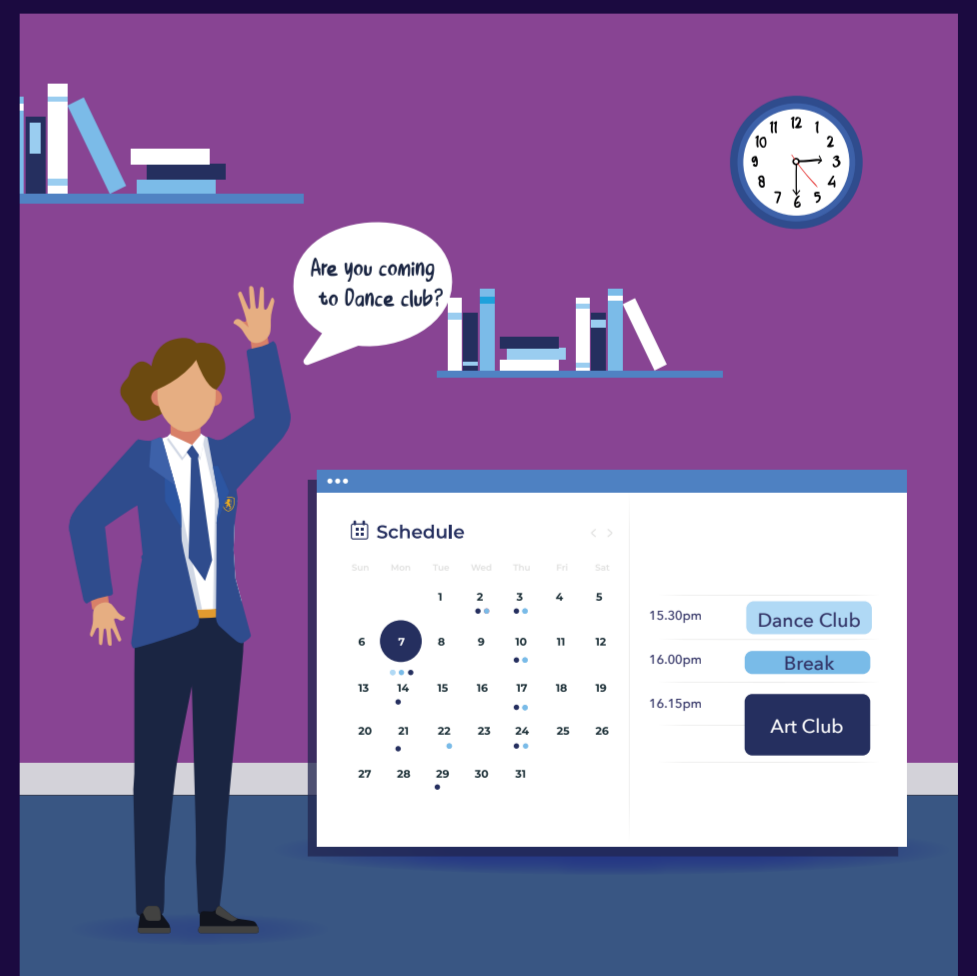

LEARN & THINK to:

- Support your child in attending school on time every day
- Read with your child at home every day
- Make sure your child has correct equipment for learning every day
- Check your child's "Show My Homework" daily and ensure a distraction free workspace
- Support your child and the school in following The Rainhill Standard for Learners

CONTRIBUTE & CARE in:

- Attend Parents Evenings and Information Evenings
- Let the school know if you have any concerns about your child
- Help us to celebrate your child by letting us know their achievements
- Help your child stay safe online and be aware of e-safety
- Support your child in getting enough sleep and limit their daily screen time





The Rainhill Standard for Teachers

LEARN & THINK

Plan lessons informed by Rosenshine principles & maximise learning time

- Include a review at the start
- Present new material in small steps with lots of practice
- Model thinking aloud
- Check understanding
- Guide student practice including independent out of class work
- Uphold the ethos of the school
- Get high success rate through having high expectations for all learners
- Scaffolds for difficult tasks

Reflect on your practice and seek to improve

- Explore and apply existing research to your practice
- Commit and contribute to Professional Development and Teaching Learning Forums to improve your practice

Reading & Oracy

- Pupils reading skills must develop in every lesson
- Prescribed reading lists are used weekly and links are seen within learning to current news articles
- Communicate clearly and effectively using Tier 2 and Tier 3 language and vocabulary to develop pupils own oracy and literacy every lesson

CONTRIBUTE & CARE

Get the basics right

- Meet & greet, end & send
- Build, maintain & repair relationships using restorative practice
- Proactive, present, persistent with ALL pupils
- Model positive behaviours and lead by example

Be calm, be clear, be kind

- Use Behaviour for Learning to strengthen relationships, remove barriers and empower pupils
- Remember every lesson is a new lesson
- Seek appropriate opportunities to manage Low Level Disruption

Building Relationships

- Acknowledge effort, spot the good & reward.
- Observe your pupils showcasing their strengths – sports matches, performing arts performances, school council debates, house events
- Build positive relationships with all stakeholders
